1. SAFETY

2. INTRODUCTION



Heavy-duty steel framework with powder coat paint finish. Easy-rolling Ø63mm composite castors with ball-bearing swivels. Vinyl covered back and headrest. Headrest is adjustable for comfort. Stand handles/feet for upright storage.

3. SPECIFICATION

4. ASSEMBLY

- 4.1. Screw on headrest assembly using two cross head screws (fig 2 - 1) to fix hinges to headrest.
- 4.2. Move headrest adjustment stay to position shown (fig 2 - 3). Screw bracket (fig 2 - 2) onto adjuster assembly.



5. OPERATION

- WARNING!** If you raise the vehicle to work under it, set the vehicle on jack stands.
- DO NOT** work under a vehicle raised on a jack(s).
- If the vehicle is on the ground, block the tyres, apply the handbrake and put it into gear or Park mode.

- 5.1. Adjust the headrest (fig 1 - 1) using the adjustment lever (fig 1 - 2) so the headrest is laying flat.
- 5.2. Keep your head flat on the headrest as you slide under the vehicle, and then adjust the headrest to a comfortable angle, using the adjustment lever (fig 1 - 2).
- 5.3. Lower the headrest to the flat position (fig 1 - 1) prior to sliding out from under the vehicle.

6. MAINTENANCE

Before each use inspect the overall condition of the creeper for broken, cracked or bent parts that may effect the proper operation.
